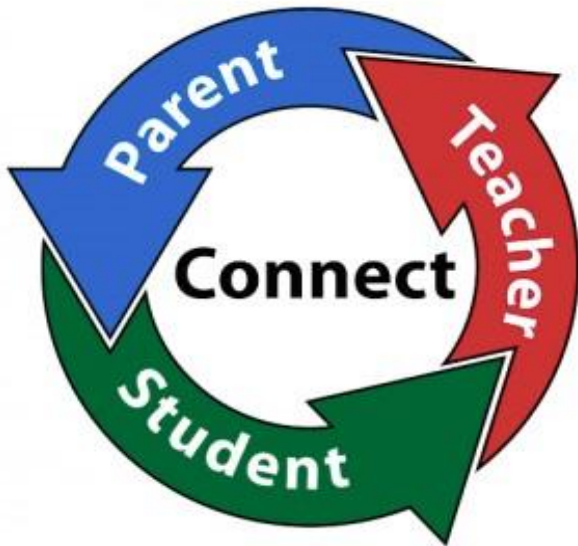

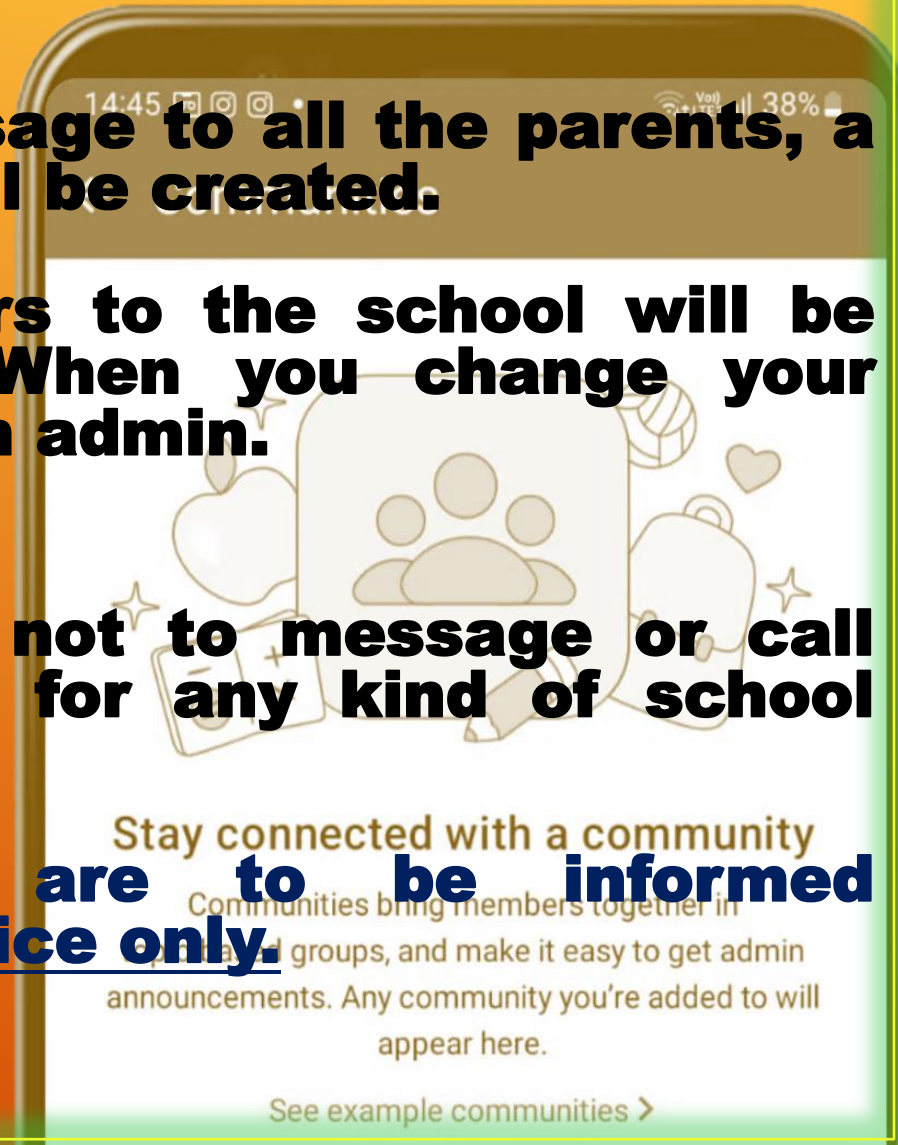

LEAVE POLICY



- A student, suffering from an **infectious or contagious disease** should submit a doctor's certificate before resuming the school.
- Also, a student suffering from an **infectious or contagious disease** will not be permitted to attend the school until it is advisable by the doctor.
- In case of illness, the school should be notified within 2 days and a medical certificate is mandatory. However, it must be informed on/before the same day of the exam. Otherwise, student will be considered as absent for the exam.



LEAVE POLICY (CONT.)



- Once in school, **no leave will be granted for half day.**
- No **Re-Test** will be conducted for casual absence on test days.
- **Average marks** will be given in case the child is representing the school outside.

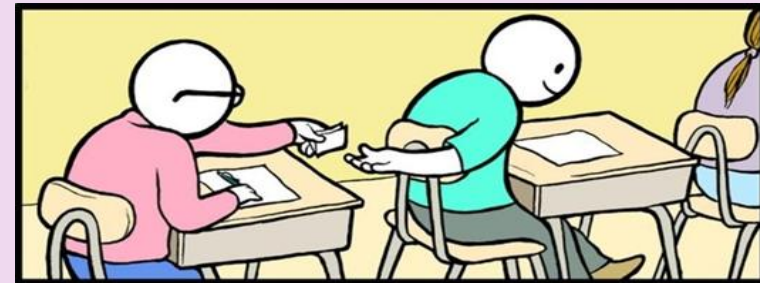
EXAM POLICY

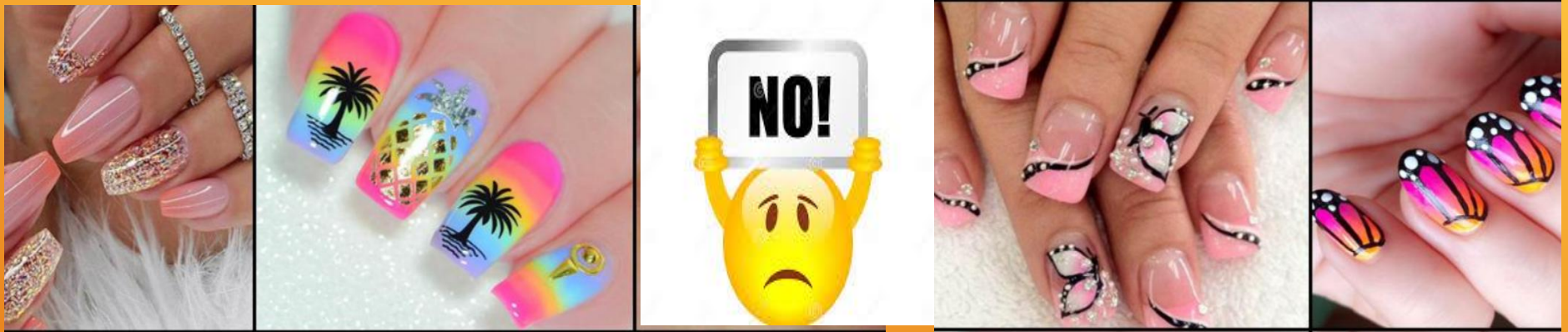

- ✓ **Eatables** are strictly prohibited on school buses.



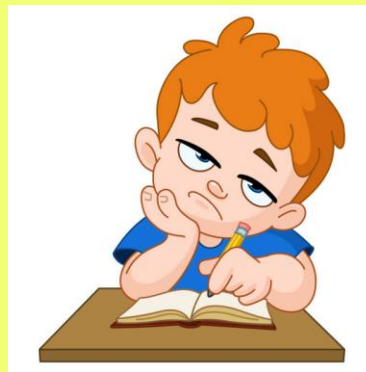
BUS DISCIPLINE

- ✓ Any complaints should be reported to the transport office or teacher /reception.

- ✓ **Strict actions** would be taken in case if **child or parent is found breaking the decorum of school bus.**



IRREGULAR C.W./H.W.

- **Plan a schedule together and ensure it is followed.**



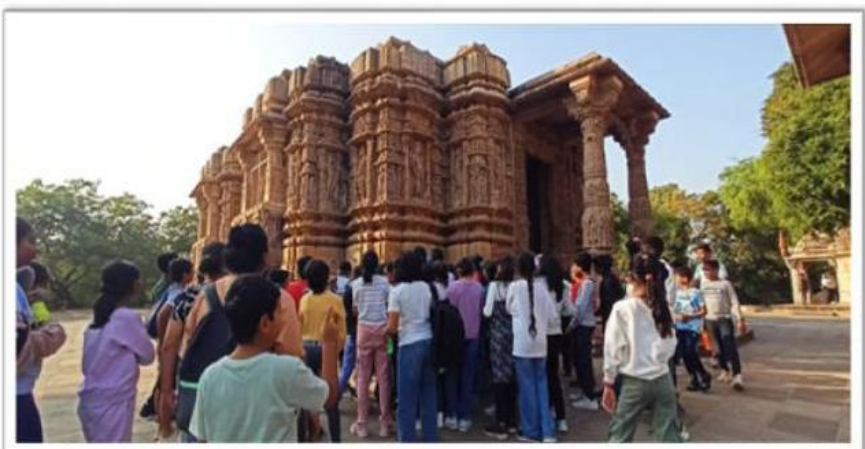
Our Expectations from parents

- Electrical gadgets, chewing gums and home food are not allowed.



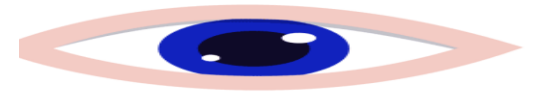

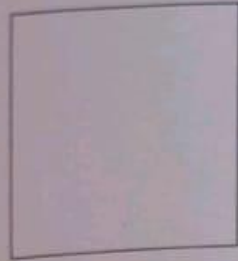
